POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTIONS IN NOVA SCOTIA OFFER NSISP GRADUATES

1. Guaranteed university admission with an average of 70% on required courses.*
2. Guaranteed waiver of the English proficiency exam for university applicants with 70% or higher in Nova Scotia grade 12 academic English (or equivalent).
3. Guaranteed scholarship to students with an average of 85% or higher.*

ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL AWARDS

NSISP graduates are eligible to receive the following:

NOVA SCOTIA



Acadia University

\$5000 tuition reduction in each year of their program at Acadia for up to four years for a maximum total value of \$20,000.



Nova Scotia Community College (NSCC)

Domestic tuition rates at NSCC in the academic year directly following graduation from a Nova Scotia high school.



ST. FRANCIS XAVIER UNIVERSITY

St. Francis Xavier University (StFX)

\$5000 scholarship renewable each year of their undergraduate program at StFX for a maximum total value of \$20,000.



Université Sainte-Anne (Usainteanne)

Domestic tuition fees for the duration of their diploma/certificate program.



Mount Allison University (Mt. A)

Domestic tuition fees for the first two years of their degree program – an estimated overall savings of \$19,790.



St. Thomas University (STU)

\$5000 NSISP tuition discount in each year of their undergraduate program. An estimated total value of over \$20,000.
